1. Whenever we see God deal wrathfully with Israel, it is always for the purpose of, and with a view to, her restoration. What are some of the Scripture verses that show us this? Some type pictures?

What does this say about God's dealings with us individually? What Scripture verses would you use to support this? (These answers are not in today's notes; consider it extra credit.)

2. Esther Chapters 1 and 2 form a complete typological picture. We must have this picture in place before we move on to Chapters 3 – 10. Describe this picture. (Be sure to explain why and how Vashti and Esther are both types of Israel.)
3. Why, as we begin Esther Chapter 3, can we not see events in a prophetically chronological order? Why do you think that is?

4. Who does Haman represent, and what type picture is drawn when we see that his position was granted by the King Himself? Briefly explain God's administration in relation to angels & men. Use Scriptures to back up your answer.

5. Can you explain WHY it is necessary for Israel (and the Church) to be both a wife and a first-born son?
